Opioid Use Disorder - Treatment

Opioid use disorder treatment options encompass a variety of approaches tailored to meet the unique needs of individuals seeking recovery. Medication-assisted treatment (MAT) combines FDA-approved medications like methadone, buprenorphine, or naltrexone with counseling and behavioral therapies. Inpatient treatment, also known as residential treatment, involves a stay at a specialized facility where individuals receive intensive care, including detoxification, medical monitoring, counseling, and therapeutic activities. Outpatient services offer flexibility by allowing individuals to live at home while attending regular treatment sessions, which may include counseling, group therapy, medication management, and ongoing support.

USDA Rural Development (RD) is a mission area within the United States Department of Agriculture serving Baxter, Benton, Boone, Carroll, Fulton, Izard, Madison, Marion, Newton, Searcy, Stone, and Washington counties that offers the following programs:

- **Section 502 Direct Loan Program:**
Assists low- and very-low-income applicants in obtaining decent, safe, and sanitary housing in eligible rural areas by providing payment assistance to increase an applicant's repayment ability.
- **504 Single Family Housing Repair Loans and Grants:**
Provides loans to very-low-income homeowners to repair, improve or modernize their homes or grants to elderly very-low-income homeowners to remove health and safety hazards.
- **Multi-Family Housing:**
Provides payments to owners of USDA-financed Rural Rental Housing or Farm Labor Housing projects on behalf of low-income tenants unable to pay their full rent.
- **Water and Waste Disposal Loan and Grant Program:**
Provides funding for clean and reliable drinking water systems, sanitary sewage disposal, sanitary solid waste disposal, and storm water drainage to households and businesses in eligible rural areas.
- **Community Facilities Direct Loan:**
Provides affordable funding to develop essential community facilities in rural areas.
